IRR CLM886 - IDENTIFY CLAIMS COVERED BY A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

Background:

This IRR was submitted by Minnesota due to a statute that requires the identification of a Collective Bargaining Agreement that affects WC coverage for some workers (for example, construction workers). For any claims where the injured worker is associated with a Collective Bargaining Agreement, the claim is required to operate slightly different and MN needs to identify and track these claims. The request is to add a Y/N indicator on the FROI to identify when an injured worker is associated with a Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Proposed Resolution – New Data Element:

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT CODE – DNxxxx

Definition: A code indicating whether a Collective Bargaining Agreement directly affects workers' compensation coverage for the employee.
