IRR CLM861 - Add Partial Denial Effective Date

Request: A Partial Denial should have a Partial Denial Effective Date to determine a new Partial Denial from a change to an existing Partial Denial Code.

Proposed Resolution:

New Data Element

PARTIAL DENIAL EFFECTIVE DATE - DNXXXX

Definition: The date from which the claim administrator is denying a portion of the claim.

Orig/Rev: xx/xx/xx Record: R22 Format: 8 DATE

DP Rule: Applicable to MTC PD (Partial Denial), or its corresponding CO, 02, or UR only. This date is used in conjunction with Partial Denial Codes (DN0294) when only a portion of the claim is being

denied.

Update MTC PD definition:

PD = Partial Denial – A specific benefit(s) is currently being denied.

Record: A49
DP Rule:

- A previous subsequent report may or may not have been filed. A previous First Report must have been filed.
- MTC PD (Partial Denial) is not to be used in conjunction with the Full Denial data elements: Full
 Denial Reason Code and Full Denial Effective Date. Denial Reason Narrative can be used to
 further explain benefits being denied.
- MTC PD is used in conjunction with Partial Denial Effective Date and Partial Denial Code.
- Depending upon the jurisdiction's requirements, for sequencing purposes, an RB may follow a PD without a previous SX.

<u>Update Partial Denial Code – DN0294 definition:</u>

PARTIAL DENIAL CODE - DN0294

Definition: A code identifying which portion of the claim is being denied at the time of the MTC PD submission.

Record: R22 Format: 1 A/N

Values: A = Denying Indemnity in whole, but not Medical

B = Denying Indemnity in part, but not Medical

C = Denying Medical in whole, but not Indemnity

D = Denying Medical in part, but not Indemnity

E = Denying Indemnity in whole and Medical in part

F = Denying Medical in whole and Indemnity in part

G = Denying both Indemnity and Medical in part

DP Rule: Applicable to MTC PD (Partial Denial) (or its corresponding CO, 02 or UR) only. Partial Denial Codes are used when only a portion of the claim is being denied. These codes are always sent with MTC PD (Partial Denial or its corresponding CO, 02, or UR), and are used in conjunction with the Partial Denial Effective Date field (not to be used in conjunction with the Full Denial data elements: Full Denial Reason Code and Full Denial Effective Date). If the Initial Payment (IP or AP) on the claim involves partial denial of indemnity benefits, the MTC IP should be preceded by MTC PD.

Section 4, page 4.12 under Jurisdiction Considerations for the SU MTC:

Jurisdictions who chose to accept the SU MTC should describe frequency limitations, if any, in their Event table.

1. Data:

a. Denials – When present, Jurisdictions could compare Denial Rescission Date to Full Denial Effective Date to determine if the Full Denial or Rescission is the most recent status of the denial of the claim. Jurisdictions should be aware that a partial denial will not have an associated effective date though a rescission date may be present communicating the partial denial rescission. Similarly, Jurisdictions could compare Denial Rescission Date to Partial Denial Effective Date to determine if the Partial Denial or Rescission is the most recent status of the denial of the claim.

Section 4, page 4.40-4.41 under Considerations for Requiring an 02 Change:

- 7. Some Data Elements, including but not limited to, Full Denial Effective Date (DN0199), Full Denial Reason Code (DN0198), Denial Reason Narrative (DN0197), Partial Denial Effective Date (DNXXXX), Partial Denial Code (DN0294), Suspension Effective Date (DN0193), Suspension Reason Code Full (DN0418), Suspension Reason Code Partial (DN0419), and Suspension Narrative (DN0233) are data elements that indicate another MTC may be due. When a jurisdiction has not TA'd the initiating event MTC, (e.g. 04, PD, SX, or PX) they may TR the 02 Change. If the Jurisdiction has not TA'd the initiating event and the Data Elements listed above are identified in the Change Variable Segment along with other Data Elements (e.g. Match Data), the Claim Administrator may need to remove the Data Elements listed above from the Change Variable Segment and resend it before reporting the next event.
- 8. Certain Data Elements can occur multiple times throughout the life of the claim, and allowing an Update to these Data Elements could pose a problem to the jurisdiction if they overlay the data, rather than storing each occurrence. Claim Administrators could be storing only one occurrence of these Data Elements and may not be able to systematically tell the difference between a new value recently entered that may be reported on an upcoming MTC, and an Update to an existing value previously reported. Jurisdictions should carefully consider allowing 02 Change transactions on these Data Elements. For example, Full Denial Effective Date (DN0199) is initially reported on an 04 (Denial). Later, the date is changed in the Claim Administrator's system. The Claim Administrator may not know if this change is a result of a new Denial requiring an 04, or an Update to the existing Denial requiring an 02 Change. Another similar case is Suspension Narrative (DN0233) and Suspension Effective Date (DN0193). In the same way, these Data Elements may be Updated and a Claim Administrator may not systematically recognize this change as a new event versus a previously reported event. Jurisdictions

who choose not to allow a change to these Data Elements may need to consider a manual process outside of EDI.
