Also, for an initial standalone MTC IP transaction that's reported after a 00/EP or FROI 04, the Benefit Payment Issue Date is used to determine if benefits were paid timely. If the Trading Partner sends either of these transactions, it rejects and another payment is issued by the time the transaction is resubmitted/accepted, the most recent payment issue date would be reported on that transaction (based on this updated DN) thus preventing Florida from being able to accurately evaluate the form and/or payment for timeliness.
